

Cypark Receives Approval for Sanitary Landfill Project

The government has issued an approval-in-principle letter to Cypark Resources Bhd for the proposed development of a new sanitary landfill in Negeri Sembilan. The approval allows Cypark to implement the project through the build, operate and transfer (BOT) method subject to the terms and conditions to be agreed, via a public private partnership. This would also enable Cypark to proceed with negotiations to finalise and formalise the terms and conditions of the concession agreement, targeted to be completed within the next six months. The project, which will treat and dispose municipal solid waste (MSW) received from many parts of Negeri Sembilan, is expected to commence this year and completed in several phases over a period of two years. The estimated flow of MSW into the project is above 1,000 tonnes per day.
