Raja Perlis presented with special RM600 and RM60 notes

ARAU: The Raja of Perlis, Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin Putra Jamalullail, has been presented with two sets of special edition commemorative banknotes in conjunction with the 60th anniversary of the Signing of the Federation of Malaysia Independence Agreement.

Bank Negara Malaysia Governor Tan Sri Muhammad Ibrahim presented the RM600 and RM60 notes sets to Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin at Istana Arau yesterday.

Raja Muda of Perlis, Tuanku Syed Faizuddin Putra Jamalullail.

In a statement, Bank Negara said it was a mark of respect for the contributions of the Conference of Rulers in paving the way for Malaysia's independence on Aug 31, 1957.

The commemorative banknotes, which were officiated by Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Muhammad V at Sasana Kijang in Bank Negara, have been issued in single RM600 notes, uncut three-in-one RM60 notes and single RM60 notes. — Bernama
