

International Accolades

UniMAP has once again created history at the international level with a 100% win at the 59th International Trade Ideas Invention New Product Exhibition (IENA), held in Nuremberg, Germany and at Brussels Innova Energy (EUREKA), Brussels, Belgium. By undertaking stringent selection and vetting process at the university level, UniMAP has managed to proudly reap the sweet bounty of success by sending in quality research products to these international competitions. This came on the heel of a string of successes by UniMAP researchers who managed to notch a 100% medal success at international design competitions held early last year in Geneva, Switzerland, INPEX, the United States of America and at IWIS, Poland. At the IENA competition, which was held in Germany from 1-4 November 2007, UniMAP had sent in two research products: Silicon Nonowire by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Uda Hashim and Palm Composite from Palm Ash by Mr. Ragunathan Santiago. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Uda won gold while Mr. Ragunathan bagged the silver. Subsequently, UniMAP sent another entry to the EUREKA Competition in Belgium and managed to bag gold there. The lucky researcher was Mr. Mohamad Shaiful Ashrul Ishak with his winning research product entitled 'Compact Bio-Fuel Burner'.
