

UniMAP Intellectual Property Management 2007 - Seminar And Workshop

The Research and Development (R&D) Unit of UniMAP had recently taken the initiative to conduct a seminar on IP Management, with the cooperation of the Centre for Intellectual Property Training (IPTC). The seminar was aimed at elevating the intellectual property awareness generally and patenting procedures in particular. This seminar cum workshop was held at the Keihklasan Hall on 26-27 December 2007. The seminar was opened by Profesor Dr. Sazali Yaakob, Head Acoustics and Applications Cluster, UniMAP on behalf of the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Research and Innovation) UniMAP. His forewords were delivered by Y. Bhg. Head Director of Malaysian Intellectual Property Organization (MyIPO), Mr. Kamel bin Mohamad.

A few interesting topics were discussed in the seminar such as 'Patents Ownership and Right', 'IP Management' and 'Commercialization and Licensing of IP', delivered by Deputy Director of MyIPO, Assoc. Prof. Rohazar Wati Zualcoble, which was attended by 70 participants. Mr. Kamal Kormin, Head Examining Division MyIPO then informed the participants on "Patent Granting Procedures" and "Patent Documents-How to utilize". The seminar was then opened to the floor where a variety of questions were asked. Assoc. Prof. Dr. R. Badlishah Ahmad, Head Embedded Computing Cluster, wrapped the seminar, followed by MyIPO Head Director.
