

TWO CONCURRENT CONFERENCES IN VIETNAM COMPILES 250 CONFERENCE PAPERS

Kangar, May 2 - Two international conferences organised by Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP) have successfully compiled 250 papers from over 10 countries which were held at Edenstar Hotel, Ho Chi Minh City Vietnam.

The two conferences were the 6th International Conference on Advanced Material Engineering & Technology (ICAMER 2018) and 4th International Conference on Green Design & Manufacture.

UniMAP's Centre of Excellence for Geopolymers & Green Technology (CEGeoGTech) manager Dr Mohd Mustaffa Al-Bakri Abdullah said the conferences were organised by the Centre of Excellence, the School of Materials Engineering and the School of Manufacturing Engineering of UniMAP.

He said that the conferences were held for two days from April 29 and ended yesterday, and received encouraging feedback by researchers from Japan, United Kingdom, Turkey, Thailand, Kuwait, Taiwan, India, Indonesia and other countries.

"This international conference seeks to uphold the field of advanced materials, geopolymer, green design and manufacturing by gathering experts from other countries to share the expertise and research produced," he said when contacted yesterday.

He added that besides the conferences, an international geopolymer

workshop (1st International Geopolymer Workshop - IGeoW 2018) was also

held especially for geopolymer researchers to sit together and discuss about

the direction of their research.

"In addition, during the special workshop geopolymer experts from China,

Taiwan, Australia and other countries agreed to organise joint grants,

student and staff mobility as well as student participation," he said.
