## UniDEBIT CARD FACILITATES ACCESS TO UniMAP STUDENTS

Pauh Putra, 26 August – In line with the rapid advances of technology, Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP) launched the UniDebit Card during new student registration day yesterday at Dewan Kecemerlangan UniMAP.

UniMAP Vice Chancellor Dato' Prof Dr Zul Azhar Zahid Jamal said that the UniDebit card offers more functions than a standard debt card to provide easy access as a UniMAP student identification or better known as a matriculation card.

"Therefore, this cashless transaction facility not only guarantees ease and safety because of lack of physical currency, but it could also help students manage their finances," he said at the 2016/2017 Academic Session Orientation Week and Family Briefing Ceremony.

He stated that the newly-introduced initiative would benefit over 2,000 new students and would eventually expand to cover almost 14,000 other UniMAP students.

The UniDebit card was launched after a memorandum of understanding (MoU) signing signed between UniMAP, represented by Zul Azhar, and Bank Muamalat Malaysia Berhad (BMMB), represented by its Chief Executive Officer Dato' Haji Mohd Redza Shah Abd Wahid in conjunction with the event.
