

Malaysia-Japan International Institute of Technology Launched by PM

Located at Universiti Teknologi Malaysia Kuala Lumpur (UTM KL), the newly established Malaysia-Japan International Institute of Technology (MJIT) has been launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Mohd. Najib Tun Abdul Razak. Besides offering undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in engineering, MJIT also promotes Japanese-style engineering and technology-based education among its students. In addition, it offers opportunities to undertake studies or research in Japanese organisations, through its support from Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM), the Malaysian government, the Japanese University Consortium (JUC) and the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA). According to a statement by UTM, the Malaysian government has pledged RM793 million, which includes a RM250 million loan from Japan for laboratory equipment in MJIT.
