

UniMAP was Given the Honour To Join KL2017 Torch Run

Kangar, June 19 - In conjunction with the 29th SEA Games which will take place in August, Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP) was given the honour to participate in the Kuala Lumpur 2017 (KL2017) Torch Run at the Perlis level, recently.

The run was rotated according to the departments and organizations begins in the yard of the MARA Skills Institute, Beseri, Padang Besar and ends at Masjid Al Barokah, Jelempok.

UniMAP representative led by the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies, Prof. Dr. Zaliman Sauli and Director of Sports Center, Suhizaz Sudin was given an opportunity to run at the Kangar parliamentary level.

The Kangar parliamentary level starts from the yard of The Store and went through Kangar-Arau Road and ends at Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Syed Sirajuddin.

On the other hand, the UniMAP team receives the torch at the checkpoint facing the School of Human Development and Technocommunication (iKOM) and brings the torch to the next checkpoint.

Also, more than 50 students and staff joined the UniMAP team in the run. Perlis is the seventh state for the 29th SEA Games Torch Run after Sarawak started on June 8.

In addition, three sports icons from UniMAP, Mohd Faiz Musa, Nazmizan Muhammad and Idris Zakaria were also honoured to head the torch run for the Arau Parliamentary level that starts from Kubang Gajah Campus, UniMAP.

A total of 90 torch bearers and 400 escort runners which involved representatives from government departments, disabled and athletes in Perlis participated in the run that covered several areas in Padang Besar, Kangar and Arau before handed over the torch to Jerlun MP Datuk Othman Aziz in Jerlun, Kedah.
